

## 1<sup>st</sup> EPROH congress emergencies @ the workplace

## **GRANT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

ICOH and EPROH scientific committee support the efforts of occupational practitioners to participate in EPROH congress **emergencies** @ **the work place**.

Two grants of 850 € each will provide funding to the international presenters of posters and/or oral communications as follow:

- One grant will provide funding to a presenter from a developing country\*
- One grant will provide funding to a young presenter (under 35 years at the date of the presentation).

Application will be evaluated during the congress by a panel of scientific and organization committees' members. Criteria will include:

- Compliance to one of the two categories of the grant,
- Confirmed interest in preparedness and response in the occupational setting,
- · Outstanding research work and expected benefits,
- Applicant's potential to have an impact in his country, area and domain of expertise,
- Applicant's willingness to disseminate and encourage other professionals in that field.

**To apply,** applicants should fill up the abstract submission form, tick the box "application grant" and send it with a short CV including birthdate. There is no fee for submission. Deadline for abstract submission is October 15<sup>th</sup> 2019. See Call for abstract at http://eproh.org/call-for-abstracts/. Notification of acceptance will be sent to all abstracts' authors by 15 November 2019, notwithstanding grant application or not. Special registration rates for ICOH members in good standing or non ICOH members apply before November 29. Accepted abstracts will need registration before December 1st 2019 notwithstanding grant application or not.

Each winner will receive the grant at the end of the 2 days congress.
